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## Recipe: Choc/Muesli Cookies

### Ingredients:

1 cup rolled oats  
1 cup flour  
1 cup sugar  
¾ cup coconut  
125g butter  
2tbsp golden syrup  
1/2tsp bicarb of soda  
1tbsp boiling water  
½ cup choc chips  
½ cup sultanans  
½ cup sesame seeds  
¼ cup sunflower seeds  
½ cup slivered almonds

### Method:

Combine oats, flour, sugar, coconut, seeds and nuts (not choc chips)  
Put golden syrup & butter into saucepan & stir over gentle heat until melted.  
Mix soda with boiling water, add to melted butter mixture, stir into dry ingredients.  
Add choc chips. Put on lightly greased oven trays.  
Cook in slow oven for 20 minutes.
